We seek wine of distinct flavour, of its place and made with respect for the vine as well as the environment. Our wine by the glass and carafe come by either 125ml or 375ml carafe so that we can offer more of the list by the glass, thus adding bottles costing £30 to the wines by the glass and carafe. This might also give you an opportunity to experiment through the list as we will change the 'by the glass' section every month. The carafe of 375ml is an ideal size for just two people but also is a good way of having a white and a red with your meal if there are just two of you.

All our wines are available to drink in the comfort of your own home, please ask the staff for an Off Sales Price List. Also, keep an eye on our website and social media for dates of our very popular Wine & Food Tasting evenings that run bi-monthly from September to May and are hosted by The Tate and Telegraph Wine Man, Hamish Anderson.
